

**A RESOLUTION FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE REPETITIVE LOSS AREA
ANALYSIS REPORT BY CHARLESTON COUNTY COUNCIL**

WHEREAS the Town of McClellanville has experienced the effects of natural and manmade hazard events; and

WHEREAS the Charleston County Building Inspection Services department, which provides services for the Town, has prepared a recommended *Repetitive Loss Area Analysis Report* in conjunction with the Community Rating System and Five Year Floodplain Management Plan with Woolpert; and

WHEREAS the recommended *Repetitive Loss Area Analysis Report* has been widely circulated for review by residents / business organizations / professional organizations of the unincorporated and incorporated areas of Charleston County, state, federal regional and local government agencies and has been supported by those reviewers; and

WHEREAS the Town of McClellanville is required to adopt the report and all amended version of this report on an annual basis if charges occur for the Town to remain eligible for certain Federal programs in which Town of McClellanville participates, and

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved that

1. *The Repetitive Loss Area Analysis Report* is hereby adopted as an official document of the Town of McClellanville, and
2. The Charleston County Building Inspection Services department is recognized as a continuing entity charged with reviewing, maintaining in accordance with Community Rating System and National Flood Insurance Program requirements, and periodically reporting on the progress towards and revisions to the plan to the Town of McClellanville.
