Significant Architectural Features: 6/1 and 9/1 windows throughout. First level has ganged windows flanking main entrance. East façade first level has oversized 1/1 windows flanked by narrow 6/1 windows. Modillions at eaves. Gabled dormer with full cornice return and four-light awning window. One brick interior chimney on the north side. French doors with transom at 2nd level entrance. Main entry has fanlight and sidelights.

Alteration Date: c. 1950; 2007

Alterations: Porch balustrade is 2007 alteration. Porch floor and foundation replaced with cement c. 1950. One story infilled porch addition at west elevation with exposed rafter tails. South elevation entry not used: steps/porch gone. Fanlight likely not original.
